In 1988, he was the recipient of San Jose State's "Outstanding Instrumentalist Award" for excellence on the guitar. He graduated with honors in 1989 with a B.A. in Music and a minor in Creative Arts. Since graduation, he has been songwriting and playing with local bands with progressive leanings such as Songquest. He has gained a strong following as one of the best hard rock lead guitarists in the Bay Area.

Tim Franks (Drums and Electronic Percussion) Referred to as "T-Bone" by friends and process servers, Tim has been developing his skills ever since playing in his school drum lines and is now highly respected as a very creative improvisational drummer with great control of acoustic as well as electronic percussion.
